Language: Students are finished with singular and plural nouns. Next, they will be learning about singular and plural possessive nouns and how to use them properly in a sentence.

Math: We discussed what makes a polygon. We will be constructing polygons and giving the names of polygons based on the polygon attributes by sides and angles. We will also be discussing what are quadrilaterals and attributes that describe quadrilaterals. Making right angles and identify them by 90 degrees also measure acute angles by relating them to right angles.

Social Studies: We will begin to learn about Lewis and Clark. The students will be researching different topics about Lewis and Clark. Our cumulating project will be the students will make a Lewis and Clark documentary. This will be on going for the next couple of weeks.

Reading: Students are finishing up with the personification poems. Next, the students will get to choose one idiom they would like to learn more about. The students will choose an idiom and build a poster using that idiom.

This week students will have their second and third meeting with their literature circle groups. Again each student will represent a certain job during their group meeting.

Science: The students will be learning about the properties and measurement of matter. We will have three different types of labs this week if we have time. Students will investigate buoyancy, mass, and volume. Each day we will discuss one of these topics and the next day they will have an investigation lab to do with a partner.
