Language: Students are finishing up with common and proper nouns. Next, they will be learning about singular and plural nouns and how to use them properly in a sentence.

Math: Continue to practice basic multiplication and division facts. We are beginning a new unit on measurement. We will be using US and metric measurement tools to measure. We will then begin with what is a polygon and making polygons and identify the polygons according to their sides.

Social Studies: We will be locating information about the Southwest region using an Atlas. Next, we will be reading and discussing Explorers and travelers on the Missouri River. Also, research information the famous explorers of Lewis and Clark.

Reading: Students are still learning about different types of figurative language. This week we are covering personifications and idioms. They will also be writing their own personification poem. Also, this week students will start literature circles. These circles are like a book club. Students will pick one of the three books I have chosen for them to read. During the next couple weeks students will read and discuss their book with their group members while completing assignments over each chapter.
